Dear colleagues!

In May-June 2026, following the results of the Forum, Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as FSBEI HE) “Naberezhnye Chelny State Pedagogical University” plans to publish a scientific and theoretical journal No. 60 dedicated to pedagogical issues.

The editorial board of the scientific journal “The Bulletin of Naberezhnye Chelny State Pedagogical University” invites scientists, professors and lecturers, postgraduate students and researchers to publish their scientific articles.

The journal is a peer-reviewed scientific publication included in the List of peer-reviewed scientific journals and publications (Russian Science Citation Index, hereinafter referred to as RSCI) for the publication of the main scientific results of dissertations for the degrees of Candidate and Doctor of Sciences.

Journal's Sections

1. Digital technologies in education.
2. Psychological and pedagogical problems and prospects for preschool and primary education.
3. Russian language and literature in a multicultural space.
4. Modern approaches and technologies for teaching mathematics, physics and computer science in the era of digitalization.
5. Current problems and prospects for the development of physical education and life safety studies.
6. Teaching a foreign language in the changing world conditions.
7. Modern historical education: the formation of all-Russian identity.

MANUSCRIPT REQUIREMENTS AND SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Volume and types of articles:

Review article: 14 to 20 pages.

Original article: from 7 to 12 pages.

Brief message: 3 to 6 pages.

2. Technical design:

File Format: Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx).

Page Setup: A4, portrait orientation. Margins: Top/bottom – 2 cm, left – 3 cm, right – 1.5 cm.

Font: Times New Roman, 14 pt.

Line Spacing: 1.5.

Paragraph Indent: 1.25 cm.

A distinction must be made between a hyphen (-) and a dash (–). The hyphen is not separated by spaces, but a space is placed before and after the dash.

Quotes like «» are used in Russian texts, and “ ” in texts in other languages.

All abbreviations must be spelled out.

Working languages: Russian, English. Articles can be submitted in all languages of the world with mandatory translation into one of the working languages. The translation must be certified by the educational organization or employer. A certified translation is provided to the editorial board in scanned form or in the original.



3. The required structure of an article (in a strict sequence):

At the beginning of the article, the UDC index is placed on a separate line in the upper left corner (attention: the indication “UDC 371” is not acceptable, a clarified index is required: for example, “UDC 371.3”) <https://www.teacode.com/online/udc/>. The article must be presented in two languages (Russian and English) in the following strict sequence. Please follow the order shown in the 'Sample design' below.

The data then goes in the following sequence:

1. Information about the author(s) in English should be aligned to the right: full name, academic degree, title, position, place of work/study (full name, city, country), e-mail, ORCID.
2. Title of the article (in capital letters, centered, bold).
3. Abstract in English (100-150 words). The purpose, methods, main results and conclusions should be reflected.
4. Key words (5-10 words/phrases).
5. Points 1-4 in Russian.
6. Citation data (last name, initials, article title, journal name): template string.
7. Main text (it is strongly recommended to divide it into sections: introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion).
8. Words of gratitude to organizations (institutions), scientific supervisors and other persons who provided assistance in the preparation of the article, information about grants, funding for the preparation and publication of the article, projects, research work, within the framework or based on the results of which the article was published (if available).
9. List of sources / References (see point 4).
10. If the article has several authors information about the contribution of each author is given at the end of the article after “Information about the authors.” This information is preceded by the words “Contribution of the authors:”. After the author's surname and initials, his personal contribution to writing the article (idea, collection of material, processing of material, writing the article, scientific editing of the text, etc.) is briefly described.
11. Information about the absence or presence of a conflict of interest (and details of such a conflict, if any) is provided at the end of the article after “Information about the authors.” If the article provides information about the contribution of each author, then information about the absence or presence of a conflict of interest is indicated after it.

This information should be provided in two languages: Russian and English.

4. Bibliography design:

The list of references is prepared in accordance with State Standard R 7.0.5-2008 “System of standards for information, library and publishing. Bibliographic reference. General requirements and rules for drawing up”. First, sources in Russian are compiled in alphabetical order. Foreign language sources are compiled after Russian language sources, also in alphabetical order.

The list contains only sources that are cited in the text, from 10 to 30 sources, for short messages – from 5 to 10 sources.

Links in the text: [5, p. 117].

The share of self-citations should not exceed 20% of the total list of references.

It is mandatory to provide a second list of References in Latin, containing transliteration of Russian-language sources and translation of their names into English. The numbering of the lists must match.

At least 1/3 of the sources must be publications from the last 5 years.



5. Submission procedure:

Author sends one email with attached article file and application form to address: **rio@tatngpi.ru** with the label "**Bulletin of NGPU**"_ **Section, Full name.**

After receiving a positive review of the article, it will be necessary to send (or hand over personally) the originals of accompanying documents to the postal address of the university: 423806, Tatarstan Republic (Tatarstan), Naberezhnye Chelny, Nizametdinov st, 28, Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education “Naberezhnye Chelny State Pedagogical University”, to “Idiyatullina Aliya Ilkhamovna”. Documents are sent through postal services (registered/regular mail), courier services (express delivery) at the expense of the sender.

The set of documents includes:

- author's application,
- consent to the processing of personal data,
- offer agreement,
- no conflict of interest claim (if there are several authors).

A scan of the supervisor's review should be attached to the article of young researchers (undergraduates, postgraduates) indicating the possibility of publishing it in open print.

EDITORIAL POLICY AND REVIEW

All incoming articles are checked in the Anti-Plagiarism system. The acceptable level of originality is at least 75%. Unfair practices to enhance originality are unacceptable.

All materials undergo a double-blind review process by members of the editorial board and invited experts.

The article must be submitted exclusively to this journal. Simultaneous submission to several publications is prohibited.

The editors are guided by the ethical principles of scientific publications (Association of Scientific Editors and Publishers – ASEP).

Manuscripts submitted with violation of the rules will not be accepted for consideration. The editors reserve the right to make necessary stylistic and editorial corrections.

All articles are peer reviewed. For all information provided in the publication the author(s) of this publication bear(s) legal and other kind of responsibility. The work is published in the author's typesetting, so it must be thoroughly prepared, proofread and must not contain spelling and punctuation errors.

The publication will be sent to the RSCI and placed in the scientific electronic library “elibrary.ru”. There are no publication fees charged to authors.

DEADLINES

Acceptance of articles for consideration for publication in one of the 2026 issues is carried out until **May 10th, 2026 inclusive**.
